Statewide Silver Alert issued for Wichita man

SEDGWICK COUNTY – The Wichita Police Department requested the Kansas Bureau of Investigation (KBI) issue a statewide Silver Alert for a man who was last seen in Wichita.

The whereabouts of 88-year-old James Elbert Bourn, of Wichita, are unknown and the public's assistance is requested to help locate him.

Bourn left to get gas on Thursday, May 16 around 4 p.m. and did not return home. He was driving a 2016 grey Ford Fusion with Kansas tag 7122ABX. The front vanity tag reads Epsilon Sigma Alpha.

Bourn is a white male who is 6 feet 1 inches tall and weighs 200 pounds. He has grey hair and brown eyes, and a mole on his right cheek. He also wears glasses, and has a fresh cut on his right hand.

Bourn was last known wearing blue jeans, white shoes, and a gray OU t-shirt. He has dementia.
