- 1). The school must be accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. Click [here](#) to find out more about accreditation.
- 2). The conversion formula used must be provided/approved by the accrediting agency.
- 3). The course of instruction and conversion formula being used must be submitted to the Board for approval.
- 4). Each course of instruction and practice shall include those core areas of education as determined and defined by the board.
