Temporary Practical Distance Learning Approval

January 12, 2022

On January 10, 2022, the Board voted to approve temporary practical distance learning, where the distance learning venue meets the statutory 1:25 student-instructor ratio, a method of tracking attendance is in place, and is done only on manikins. This temporary approval is valid until February 24, 2022 and is limited only to students being affected by COVID-19 quarantine requirements.

As a reminder, distance learning for the theory portions of the curriculum is currently allowable under the recently updated K.A.R. 69-3-8 (c).

<u>69-3-8 Curricula and credits.</u> (c) Any instructional classroom may be a place where theory instruction is provided in a traditional classroom setting or in a distance education format.
