

Notice Regarding Extension of Licenses Pursuant to Executive Order 21-02:

On January 26, 2021, Kansas Governor Laura Kelly issued Executive Order 21-02, extending Executive Order 20-64, granting the Kansas Board of Cosmetology the authority to extend without penalty the renewal deadlines for licenses that expired or will expire during the State of Disaster Emergency.

This order is effective immediately and remains in force until it is rescinded, or the statewide State of Disaster Emergency expires, whichever is earlier. The State of Disaster Emergency, as extended by the legislature on January 25, 2021, expires March 31, 2021.

Therefore, all complete renewal applications for licenses expired or set to expire between March 12, 2020 and March 31, 2021, as well as any required continuing education, will be considered timely if received by the Board on or before March 31, 2021. However, the Board will consider the renewal application late and the license invalid if received after March 31, 2021, and a late fee will apply.
